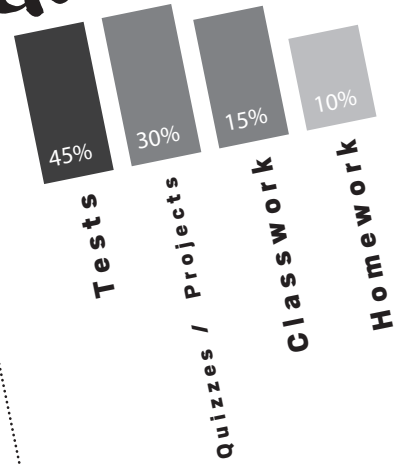

Rules & Expectations

Late Homework = No Credit

- *Homework is used in class as a teaching tool * Math homework is corrected in class
- * Language Arts homework needs to be completed to complete summary and textual evidence pages.
- *Homework supports classwork - without it students are behind and will not be able to keep up with the class lesson for the day.

Plagiarism and Cheating

*To plagiarize is defined as taking ideas and writings of another and passing them off as one's own.

Students caught plagiarizing will be given a ZERO for the assignment.

* This includes COPYING from a friend's paper and also sharing answers with a friend. Don't do it!

We Are Prompt, Productive, Polite, and Prepared

- *Be on time! *No sleeping in class.
- *No Heads Down on Desks - class time is active!
- *Students will maintain a respectful and positive attitude
- *Speak and Act as if you were in front of your grandmother!
- *No GUM or FOOD or DRINKS (besides water) are allowed in the classroom. Don't try to sneak them!

Absent Work

- *Absent students will check online websites for missed work.
- * We allow a week of makeup time for missed work due to absence.
- *Please have student pick up worksheets when they return back to school. *Often teachers won't have "handouts" for parents to pickup-check website.

- * Grades will be available in the **AERIES Home Portal**
- Please **check AERIES regularly**, and feel free to ask any questions that you might have about a particular grade. We make mistakes, so this is your opportunity to make sure everything is correct! This can be done before or after class or via e-mail.
- If you do not have an AERIES login, you can **get one from the front office.**

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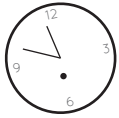
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Absentee Policy

- 1 YES – WE DID SOMETHING IMPORTANT WHILE YOU WERE ABSENT.** It is your responsibility to check kanley.org the day you return to class to find out what you missed. Check the Absent Work Folders, the class website, and talk to your buddies at your table.
- 2 You Have ONE WEEK** from the day you have returned from your absent to make up missed work. After, missing assignments will be accepted with a late penalty.

- 3 Test and Quiz Make-Ups** - Students are responsible for making an appointment with their teacher to make up any missed test or quiz. These appointments are either before or after school - not at lunch - your teachers like to eat lunch at lunch time!
- 4 No Credit for Assignments After a Week** - Any assignment you haven't make up after a week will not be accepted. The gradebook will show an empty red cell that won't be changed. A grade of "0" will be entered if a student turns in work that earns a "0".

Other Items Worth Knowing...



*** Independent Study for Absences** - For students who are missing 5 or more school days. Inform BOTH the office and the teachers at least one week before the date of the absence. Work will often NOT be the exact assignments from class. Students are required to turn in their work the DAY they return back from the absence. If work is not fully completed the absence will NOT be listed as excused and the incomplete work may affect student grades.

If you are having issues at school or at home, or realize you need something to make sure you can do your absolute best in school. Please let us know. We are not mind readers! Often if we know about a student's particular situation we can make changes to help.

***EXTRA CREDIT POLICY:**
We give opportunities throughout the school year for extra credit. Please take advantage when it is offered.



* Year of Self Advocacy

When students can solve a grading issue or take an active part of solving a conflict it creates a win - win opportunity where students are able to grow into proactive people. We highly encourage students to speak with their teachers before or after class if there is a concern.

Notice...

Absent work will be entered in AERIES - eventually. We have many things to do as teachers to make sure the class runs smoothly, entering absent work is at the bottom of the list. DO NOT repeatedly ask about the status of your make up work.

*** I KNOW I TURNED THAT ASSIGNMENT IN! What to do When An Assignment is listed as missing.**
1st - Check the "no name" pile. If you find your paper, put your name on it and turn it in to the teacher for partial credit. 2nd - Check in YOUR FOLDERS and BACKPACK - just in case! 3rd - ONLY after completing the first two steps, then talk with the teacher. FYI - the teacher will ask if your did steps 1 & 2!

Plagiarism:

What it is & how to avoid it

To plagiarize is defined as taking ideas and writings of another and passing them off as one's own. Students caught plagiarizing will be given a ZERO for the assignment.

Plagiarism includes...

- 1 turning in someone else's paper as your own**
- 2 copying a friend's paper 5 minutes before class (or having another teacher catch you copying work in his/her classroom)**
- 3 failing to cite a source**
- 4 copying an author's exact words and passing them off as your own**

Cheating...

*The teacher will notify the administration and contact parents if cheating is suspected.
*The student will be given a failing grade for that particular test, assignment, for the grading period, or for the semester.
*Students involved in cheating may be excluded from school activities.
